

What is a Dental Implant?

Dental implants are placed into the gums and have a shape similar to a screw. They go into your jawbone and bond with the natural bone that is in place, providing an attachment point for the crown. A crown is an artificial tooth designed to blend in seamlessly with your existing teeth.

Post Op Instructions for Dental Implants



Bleeding

Bite down on a sterile gauze for 2 hours. It is advised to swallow the blood and saliva.



Swelling

Use an ice pack on swollen area for 5 minute intervals.



Prescription drugs

To relieve pain and avoid infections, please take the drugs prescribed by your dentist.



Meals

Avoid solid food and the use of straws for 1 week.



Exercise and Leisure

Please avoid rigorous activities and saunas for 2~3 days after surgery.



Drinking and/or smoking

Please avoid drinking and/or smoking for at least 1 month to prevent infections.



Proper Oral Hygiene

Use of proper brushing techniques and anti-bacterial mouthwash every day can further prevent infection.
